Pitching Session

During the pitching session, athletes will learn about new equipment, various techniques for different pitches, and how to improve your skills to become a stronger and more dominant pitcher. Much individual attention will be provided during this session. **Please bring your own catcher.**

Hitting Session

During this session, athletes will receive individual attention and will work on skills they need to improve on. You will also learn about new training aids to become more powerful and make consistent contact.

Slapping Session

Slappers will learn the correct footwork and new drills to become a more effective slapper. Various types of slaps will be taught.

Catching Session

During the catching session, athletes will learn various skills to enhance the productivity behind the plate. This includes, blocking, framing, footwork, throwing. We will also discuss how to call a game, communicating with the field, and tracking base runners. Much individual attention will be provided during this session. **Please bring your own catching gear.**

Infield Session

During the infield session, athletes will learn new drills to improve their infield skills. Individual attention will be provided for each position and learn skills every infield position needs to know such as: throwing, footwork, communication, and knowledge of different situations.

Outfield Session

During the outfield session, athletes will learn new drills to improve their outfield skills. These skills include: angles, fielding, throwing accuracy, fielding, and communication.
