The University of Dubuque Men's Soccer Program is extremely excited to announce the 2013 University of Dubuque Summer Advanced Players Camp. This 2-day residential camp, held on the University of Dubuque Campus, will give premier High School aged (see below) boys soccer players the opportunity to participate in collegiate training sessions designed to give each individual a taste what college soccer at the highest level is all about.

The Summer Advanced Players Camp will provide each participant with on-field collegiate practice sessions held by the USSF and NSCAA licensed University of Dubuque coaching staff. The camp will also provide players with classroom film sessions, and a Dry-Fit University of Dubuque Men's Soccer training shirt.

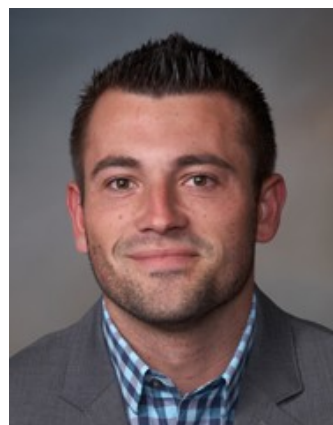

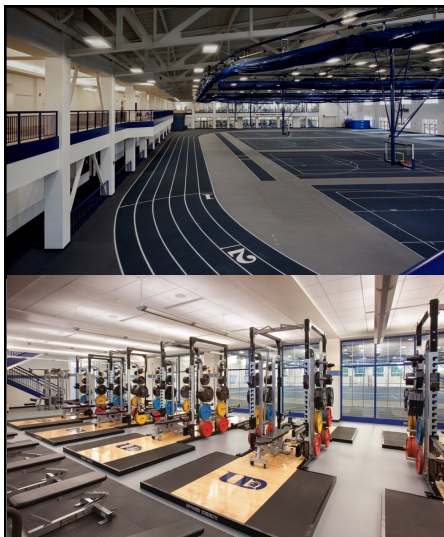
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UD FACILITIES



Oyen Field (Soccer Field)

Located adjacent to U. S. Highway 20, the field is 80 yards wide by 120 yards long and was the second field in the Iowa Conference to have a lighted natural grass turf. The field serves both as a practice and game site for the men's and women's soccer teams. Oyen Field also has a brand 2-story press box. The press box has a additional locker-room on the first floor.



CRWC (Chlapaty Recreation and Wellness Center)

The Chlapaty Recreation and Wellness Center, an 87,000 square foot facility opened in the fall of 2008 includes:

- 6900 square foot, 2-level fitness center including areas for cardiovascular workout and free weights/machines;
 - 200 meter, 6-lane indoor track with synthetic flooring for fitness walking and performance;
 - 4 multi-use courts nested in the center of the track for intramurals and indoor practices;
 - 16 foot-wide concourse running the length of the facility, overlooking the track and courts; home, visitor, officials and faculty/staff locker rooms; a juice bar/lounge area.
- The CRWC is known to be one of the premier athletic facilities in the region.



Lodging/ Park Village

Park Village consists of 3 and 4 story apartment buildings. Each of the apartment buildings are designed as a living and learning community for upper-class undergraduate students. The apartments were built into the campus's sloping topography and have walk-in access on two levels.

Completed in the fall of 2003, the three story buildings contain 17 four bedroom apartments. In Fall 2004, the Babka, Cottingham, and Siekmann Houses were completed and consist of 22 five bedroom apartments. Each building contains its own laundry facilities. Park Village also has large community room that is used for student life and academic programming and a community fitness center in the Babka building.
