What is the college ambassador program?

An innovative program hosted by UD's Career Services, which enables local employers to partner with UD's Academic Departments, in an effort to build stronger relationships with faculty members and connect current students to internship and employment opportunities.

Is there an academic initiative?

Yes, this is an opportunity for employers and departmental faculty members to discuss the following:

- standards for internships and entry level positions within the ambassador's work environment
- course curriculum relevant to the major
- short and long-term expectations of functional and soft skills
- time-frame initiatives for student application processes

Expectation after initial meeting?

College ambassadors will be invited to conduct an informational interview day with UD students on-campus, this event will be hosted by UD's Career Services. These informational interviews will be a prescreening process for college ambassadors to share current internship/employment opportunities with students and directing them to the application process. Students will be required to sign-up for the interview in advance thru UD's Career Services. Each interview will be 15 to 30 minutes in length.
