UNDERGRADUATE SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS POLICY FOR FEDERAL, STATE, AND INSTITUTIONAL FINANCIAL AID:

Students attending full-time have a maximum of five academic years to complete a program of study at the University of Dubuque. Part-time students have a maximum of ten academic years to complete a program.

Academic progress will be measured both qualitatively and quantitatively. A minimum grade point average and a minimum number of credit hours completed in an academic year are requirements. The following qualitative measure at the end of each semester indicates the required minimum cumulative grade point average required to receive financial aid.

Transfer students will enter the time frame at the point according to the number of credits earned and accepted by the University of Dubuque for prior education at other institutions.

For quantitative measure, students enrolled two full-time semesters must complete 24 credit hours per academic year. Students enrolled two part-time semesters (6 to 11 credit hours per semester) must complete the minimum prorated credit hours per academic year.
