**\*Course Admission Criteria:**

1. Earn a minimum Pre-Nursing (PNRS) GPA of 3.00

2. Must earn a "C" or better in all PNRS requirements. No PNRS course may be repeated more than once. PNRS requirements include the first two years of classes, with the exception of WVS I, II and Gen. Ed. requirements listed above,
