Minimum 2.0 GPA to transfer; AA or AS fulfills all core requirements with exception of Judeo-Christian Tradition unless took class as part of AA or AS; AAS <u>does not</u> fulfill all core/general education requirements

Business & Accounting majors – <u>Recommended courses</u>: Financial Accounting, Managerial Accounting, Principles of Financial Management, Principles of Management, Principles of Marketing, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics

Criminal Justice majors – <u>Recommended courses</u>: Intro to Sociology, Intro to Criminal Justice, Police & Society, Criminal Law & Procedure, Intro to Corrections, Criminology

Education majors – GPA 2.75; ALL courses for education majors require grade of C or better; CAAP Test required; <u>Recommended courses</u>: US History or American Government, Biology with lab, Intro to Literature

Nursing majors – GPA 3.0; ALL nursing prerequisites require grade of C or better and minimum 3.0 GPA in all 4 science courses; <u>Required courses</u>: CNA, Composition I & II, Public Speaking, College Algebra, Statistics, General/Organic/Biochemistry with lab (specific chemistry class for nursing), Microbiology with lab, A & P I & II with labs, Nutrition, Intro to Psychology, Developmental Psychology, Intro to Sociology; labs for science courses must be in-person
