Last day to withdraw from a full-term course.

DEGREE AND ACADEMIC STANDING REQUIREMENTS

- Full-time status = 12-17 course credits a term
- A minimum of 120 credits are required to earn a bachelor's degree
- Earn a C or better in the following core curriculum courses MATH 107,112, 150, 230 or 250; ENG 101; ENG 104; COM 101
- Remember 2-2-12 to stay in good academic and financial standing
 - 2.0 minimum term GPA (grade point average)
 - 2.0 minimum cumulative GPA (grade point average)
 - 12 credits minimum earned each term (fall and spring semester)
