She has taught in various capacities at UD since 2004, directing handbell and choral ensembles and teaching voice. Eby maintains a private voice studio and is the conductor and co-founder of the Julien Chamber Choir, a select ensemble of professional and amateur musicians from the Dubuque area. In the summers, you can find her directing music for shows at the Grand Opera House. An active pianist, she serves at First Presbyterian Church and University of Dubuque Theological Seminary.

Eby received a master's degree in choral conducting from the University of Oregon, where she performed in the Oregon Bach Festival chorus under the direction of Helmuth Rilling. She received a bachelor's degree in music education and piano from Westmont College in Santa Barbara, California.
