

15 YEARS OF TRIO AT UNIVERSITY OF DUBUQUE

As we celebrate 60 years of TRIO nationally and 15 years at the University of Dubuque, we reflect on a year of meaningful programming. Highlights include sending students to the Yale Moot Court Competition and organizing a graduate visit to Iowa City. In 2023-2024 we hosted 28 events with 408 attendances, averaging 15 participants per event. In April 2024, we awarded over \$54,000 in scholarships to 71 participants, with more than half of our annual attendees meeting all deadlines and qualifying for support. These milestones reflect the lasting impact of TRIO, and we're excited to continue building on this success.
