OFFICE OF RESIDENCE LIFE GOAL STATEMENT

By supporting the mission of the University of Dubuque, the Residence Life program exists as an integral part of the educational mission and Student Life services of the institution. An important goal of the Residence Life program is to provide a living and learning environment that supports the educational goals of each student, while providing students with room for personal growth and development.

Residency Policy

The University of Dubuque residency policy stipulates that all students having earned less than 58 credits must reside in campus housing units, space permitting, unless they meet one of the following criteria:

- Married
- Have a child/children
- Three or more years since high school graduation
- Living with and commuting daily from the home of an immediate relative (parent, grandparent, sibling, legal guardian) within 50 miles of Dubuque

If you would like to seek an exemption from this policy for any reason, including those mentioned, you must complete an Off Campus Housing Request form that you can obtain from the Office of Student Life. Your request will be reviewed and a written response will be forwarded to you. Students discovered to be living off-campus without authorization from the Director of Residence Life will be required to provide documentation that proves compliance with the policy or they will be charged room rental fees for residence hall space.

Having read this application, I understand the above guidelines as stated. In the event of cancellation or termination of this agreement during the year, I would forfeit \$100.00 from my deposit.
